- Never consume substances that impair judgement such as alcohol, drugs and medications.

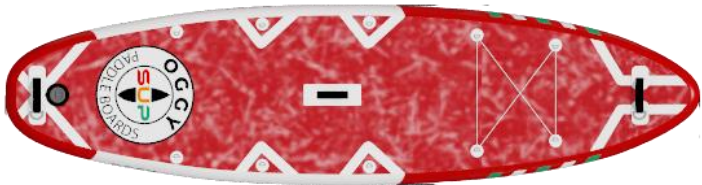
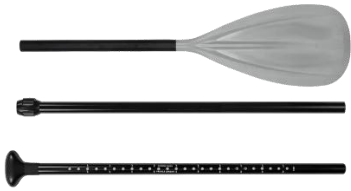
SAFETY RULES

- Before using this product, the user should take a lesson from a certified school. This product should not be used by anyone who is not experienced withstand up paddle boards.
- Always wear a Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (PFD) when using this product.
- Always wear a surf leash with using the paddle board. Be sure to examine the surf leash before and after each use and replace if needed.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

- Do not use in weather conditions that might affect your ability to control the paddle board.
- Do not use in more than 10 knots of wind or offshore wind conditions. Wind conditions may result in serious injury.
- Do not use in thunderstorms and lightning conditions.
- Caution should be used when carrying this product. Carrying the board in windy conditions may result in serious injury to the user or others nearby.
- Do not use the product in conditions that are beyond the user's ability (examples, but not limited to high surf, riptides, currents, or river rapids)
- Do not use this product after dark or in conditions where there is poor vision.
- Do not use this product near other boat traffic or watercrafts.
- Check local city and state laws and regulations before using the paddle board.

Set Up and Inflation

PADDLE BOARD SETUP

1. To get started, take out the contents of the bag and unroll the paddle board.
2. Once the paddle board is unrolled, locate the inflation valve on top of the board and the pin inside. Twist to make the pin spring into the upright position. This will stop air from escaping after your board is inflated.
3. Next, take out the pump and connect the hose with the nozzle end to the inflation valve on the board. To do this, push the hose down and twist clockwise to lock it into place.
4. Then, attach the other end of the hose to the hand pump and push the feet of the pump into the ground for leverage as you begin to inflate. On the back of the pump is a small dial. When the dial is turned to the right, the pump will push air into your board as you push down and pull up on the pump handle to help expedite the process.
5. Start pumping! The needle on the gauge won't begin to move until the board hits around 7psi of air. Note, there is a significant difference between a deflated board and 7psi. Visually, the board will look practically full once you reach that threshold. Aka, no your gauge isn't broken, just keep pumping! Continue to pump until the board is hard and fully inflated — around 12-15psi. As the board gets closer to max air capacity, it may get harder to pump. At this point, turn the dial to the left, so that air is only forced into the paddle board when you push down on the pump.
6. Once the board is fully inflated, secure the cap on the inflation valve.
7. Now that your board is fully inflated, flip it over to install the fin. First, take the super bolt and screw the small plate onto the screw until it sits at the end of the screw head.
8. Then, place the screw with the plate at the bottom into the fin box so that the bolt is pointed thread end upward. The super bolt should be towards the nose end of the fin box.
9. Next, fit the fin into the box, aligning the previously placed bolt to go through the hole at the base of the fin. Tightly fasten the nut to the bolt to secure the fin in place.

10. Finally, attach the leash. Locate the metal d-ring at the tail of the paddle board and loop the leash tie through it.
11. Then take the Velcro strip and loop it through the leash tie. The other end of this will go around your ankle once you are on the board.

3-PIECE PADDLE SETUP

Our hybrid 3-piece paddle is travel friendly with a lightweight design to maximize your performance. Plus, it only takes 2 simple steps to assemble!

1. Open the clamp and slide the middle shaft into the blade piece until the metal pin is in place. Then, close the clamp.
2. Do the same with the handle piece by placing it into the middle shaft, and then close the clamp to secure. Troubleshooting: if the handle continues to slide upwards after the clamp is closed, the screws on the clamp need to be tightened.

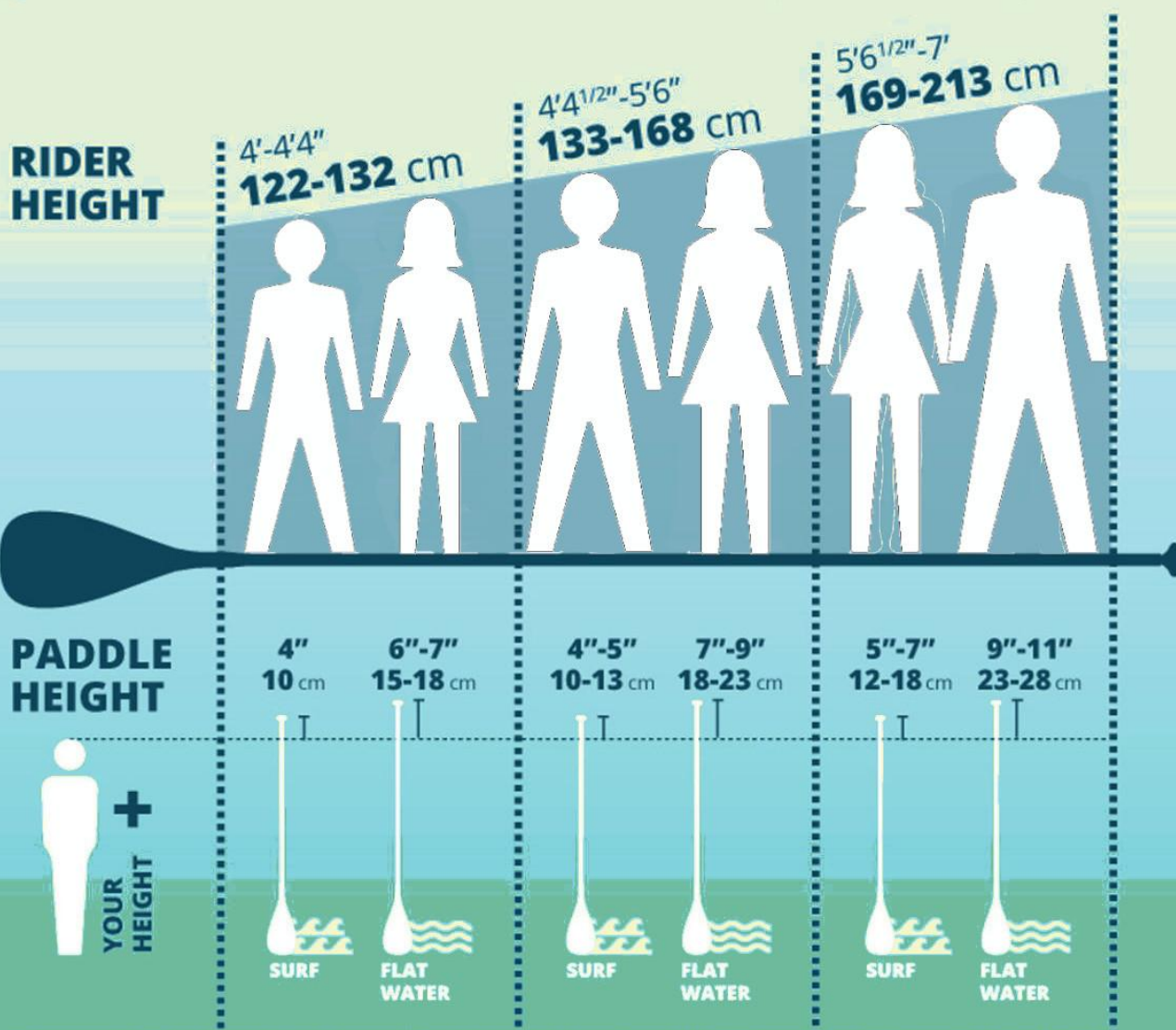
BOARD DEFLATION STEPS

1. Clear any water or debris out of the valve areas.
2. Remove the valve cover from the valve.
3. Slowly press down of the valve stem to start letting air out of the board. There will be an initial burst of air, but that will slow down. Once the air flow has slowed down, press the valve stem all the way down and turn clockwise to lock it in the “open” position.

Care and Maintenance

DO NOT LEAVE IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT

Damage resulting from heat and UV is not covered by manufacturer's limited warranty.

Never leave the paddleboard exposed to direct sunlight when out of water for an extended period. Try to keep in the shade when not in the water. If you must expose your board to direct sunlight during transport or temporary storage, it is best to keep the bottom facing up.

RECOMMENDED PRESSURE 12-14 PSI

Glide boards can hold up to 25 PSI, however, the recommended PSI is 12-14 PSI as the board will remain rigid at 14 PSI and no further benefit is gained when inflating over 14 PSI. If inflated cold to 25 PSI, and then the board is placed in direct sunlight pressure will increase from the heat causing potential over inflation and damage to the seams - this is not covered by warranty.

PUMP MAINTENANCE

Over time, the pump may naturally lose lubrication and you may need to reapply. We recommend white lithium grease. To lubricate, unscrew the top and pull-out plungers and spread a thin layer of lubricant on the black gasket on the bottom of each plunger and then reassemble. Also, regularly clean the air filter located under the pressure gauge. The gauge unscrews from the top by hand.

BOARD MAINTENANCE

Sun, sand, and saltwater will degrade any man-made material over time. Rinse off sand and saltwater deposits from your paddle board with fresh water and store in a cool, dry environment after each use.
